

Respect Code of Conduct for Mini Soccer Players



Whiteley Wanderers Football Club Respect Code of Conduct for Mini Soccer players both Male and Female aged U10 is as follows:

When playing football, I will:

- Make every effort to be punctual for training and matches.
- Always be equipped correctly including wearing shin pads.
- Always play to the best of my ability and set a positive example for others.
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time or use inappropriate language.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the Referee or my Coach/Manager.
- Respect Club and others' equipment.
- Never criticise individuals or team mates just encourage them.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the Referee and accept their decisions without protest.
- Shake hands with the other team and Referee prior to kick off and at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my Coach/Team Manager tells me.
- Ensure through the support of my parents that subscriptions are paid on time.
- If required talk to someone I trust or the Club Welfare Officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my Club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, Referee or Team Manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the Coach or the Club Committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the Club.

In addition:

- My Club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my Club.
