Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

Whiteley Wanderers Football Club Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers is as follows:

I will:

- Remember that children/youths play for FUN.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided).
- Let the Coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, Referee and match officials.
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- Ensure the appropriate subscriptions fees are paid to the club as required monthly.

As a parent, carer or supporter, should I use a social network site or open forum like Facebook that may be viewed by anyone, **I will never comment in a negative manner** about a game, Officials, Players or any other aspect of Club business.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my Club, League, County FA or The FA:

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a Club or League Official.
- Required to meet with the Club, League or CFA Welfare Officer.
- Required to meet with the Club Committee.
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course.
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the Club.
- Requested by the Club not to attend future games.
- Suspended or have my Club membership removed.
- Required to leave the Club along with any dependents.

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the Club.
